

**ORDER**

On consideration of appellant's motion for stay, appellee's motion for leave to file an opposition in excess of the page limitation, and the lodged opposition, it is

ORDERED that appellee's motion for leave to file an opposition in excess of the page limitation is granted and the Clerk shall file the lodged opposition. It is

FURTHER ORDERED that the motion for stay is denied. Even if we assume *arguendo* that the motion is not moot (on the grounds that the sale of certain assets has already occurred), appellant has not met the requirements for a stay. *See Barry v. Washington Post Co.*, 529 A.2d 319, 321 (D.C. 1987) (citing *In re Antioch Univ.*, 418 A.2d 105, 109 (D.C. 1980)).
