

NOTICE OF REHABILITATION TO CHARTERED EMPLOYEES

On October 19, 2012, William P. White, Commissioner of Insurance, Securities and Banking for the District of Columbia petitioned the Superior Court of the District for an Order of Rehabilitation of DC Chartered Health Plan, Inc. (“Chartered”). The Order appoints the Commissioner as Rehabilitator with full control over the assets of Chartered and full authority to administer Chartered’s business.

The Commissioner, as Rehabilitator, is retaining the management and the employees of Chartered and continuing Chartered’s business under its Medicaid contract with the District of Columbia. This means that

- Chartered employees continue their employment with Chartered with no change in employment status or in payment of compensation.
- Chartered Medicaid enrollees will continue to receive services without interruption.
- Providers will continue to be paid for services delivered to enrollees under the provider agreements currently in place.
