ORDER OF DISCHARGE AND DISSOLUTION

The matter comes before the Court upon the Petition of Chester McPherson, Interim Commissioner of the Department of Insurance, Securities, and Banking (“Commissioner”), Liquidator of Regional Health Insurance Company, A Risk Retention Group (“Regional,” or “the Company”), by and through Phillip E. Stano, as Special Deputy Insurance Commissioner and Liquidator for an Order of Discharge and Dissolution.

Upon consideration of all reports filed in this matter¹, any opposition thereto and any argument of counsel, the Court concludes that the Commissioner’s statutory duties pertaining to the Liquidation were properly performed and have been completed, that the appropriate financial reports have been issued and have been approved, and that dissolution of the corporate existence of Regional is appropriate, as is discharge of the Liquidator.

WHEREFORE, it is this 24th day of February, 2014, hereby

ORDERED, that said Petition is **GRANTED**; and it is further

ORDERED, that Regional is dissolved in the District of Columbia in accordance with D.C. Code § 31-1344(a); and it is further

ORDERED, that the Commissioner, having properly performed his duties, is discharged as Liquidator of Regional, in accordance with D.C. Code § 31-1344(a); and it is further

ORDERED, that Phillip Stano, as Special Deputy Commissioner and Liquidator of Regional, having properly performed his duties in connection with these proceedings, is discharged as Special Deputy Commissioner and Liquidator of Regional, in accordance with D.C. Code § 31-1344(a); and it is further

ORDERED, that the fees of the Special Deputy Commissioner are hereby approved, and that payment of any outstanding fees shall be made to the Special Deputy Commissioner subject to the Commissioner's approval; and it is further

ORDERED, that the remainder of the estate, if any, of Regional shall be distributed in accordance with D.C. Code §§ 31-1340 and 1343; and it is further

ORDERED, that all documents related to this proceeding shall be stored at the direction of the D.C. Department of Insurance, Securities, and Banking for four (4) years in accordance with D.C. Official Code § 31-1346; and it is further

ORDERED, that these proceedings are hereby **TERMINATED** in accordance with D.C. Code § 31-1344,

SO ORDERED.
