DEFAULT DECISION AND ORDER OF REVOCATION

The Hearing Officer enters a default decision and order of revocation against Respondent, Matthew R. Phillips based upon the following facts:

1. Respondent Matthew R. Phillips is licensed as an individual non-resident producer authorized to transact insurance business in the District of Columbia
2. Respondent's non-resident producer license No is AI 2816842.
3. A Notice to Show Cause was sent to Respondent on April 26, 2007 informing him of the charges against him.
4. Charge I of the Department's Show Cause Notice alleged that Respondent failed to remain licensed and in good standing in his home state as required by D.C. Official Code § 31-1131.08 for which the Commissioner may revoke his District of Columbia insurance producer's license pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 31-1131.12(a)(2)(2001).
5. Charge II of the Department's Show Cause Notice alleged that Respondent's insurance producer's license was revoked by the State of California, Department of Insurance pursuant to California Insurance Code §§ 1668(1) and 1738 for violation of §1736.5 for which the Commissioner may revoke your District of Columbia insurance producer's license pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 31-1131.12(a)(2)(2001)
6. Charge III of the Department's Show Cause Notice alleged that Respondent's insurance producer's license was revoked by another state for which the

Commissioner may revoke his District of Columbia insurance producer's license pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 31-1131.12(a)(9)(2001).

7. Charge IV of the Department's Show Cause Notice alleged that Respondent failed to report to the Commissioner administrative action taken against his insurance producer license in another jurisdiction within thirty (30) days of the final disposition of the matter in violation of D.C. Official Code § 31-1131.17(a) for which the Commissioner may revoke his insurance producer's license pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 31-1131.12(a)(2)(2001).
8. The Department of Insurance, Securities and Banking sent, via certified mail, dated April 26, 2007 Notice to Show Cause IB-SC-10-07, to Respondent at 6318 Southridge Court, Spotsylvania, VA 22553, Respondent's last known address of record.
9. The Notice to Show Cause sent to Respondent, directed him to appear before the Department of Insurance, Securities and Banking, Suite 701, 810 First Street, NE in Washington, D.C., on June 12, 2007 at 10:00 a.m.
10. After notice was duly given, a public hearing was held for the purpose of determining whether the license of Matthew R. Phillips, Respondent, should be revoked. During the hearing the Government's representative, Assistant Attorney General Charlotte Parker asked that Charge II of the Notice to Show Cause be amended by adding Specification B from Charge III and deleting such specification from Charge III. There being no objection, the Hearing Officer amended Charge II and Charge III accordingly.
11. The Respondent failed to appear at the Show Cause Hearing or have a representative appear on his behalf.
11. At the hearing, Charlotte Parker, Assistant Attorney General, presented evidence that Respondent was given proper notice of the hearing. She also presented sufficient evidence to justify the revocation of Respondent's individual non-resident insurance producer's license (See Governments Exhibits 1 - 4 and the tape recording of the hearing.)

**ORDER**

Based upon the record and the foregoing facts, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that a **DEFAULT DECISION IS ENTERED** against the Respondent for failing to appear. **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT** Respondent's individual non-resident producer's license No. AI 2816842 is **REVOKED**.
