CONSENT ORDER

WHEREAS, MARK W. WARDLOW is a District of Columbia individual insurance producer with a business address listed as 3617 12th Street, NE, Washington, DC 20017;

WHEREAS, MARK W. WARDLOW's individual resident insurance producer's license will expire on May 31, 2009;

WHEREAS, MARK W. WARDLOW intentionally withheld, misappropriated, or converted monies or properties received in the course of doing insurance business in violation of D.C. Official Code § 31-1131.12(a)(4);

WHEREAS, MARK W. WARDLOW demonstrated incompetence, untrustworthiness, or financial irresponsibility in the conduct of business in the District in violation of D.C. Official Code § 31-1131.12(a)(8);

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of the Department of Insurance, Securities and Banking (Department), has the authority to place on probation, suspend, revoke, levy fines, order restitution and take other action against an insurance producer who has violated any provision of D.C. Official Code § 31-1131.12(a);

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: That MARK W. WARDLOW shall reimburse Travelers Casualty and Surety Company of America (Travelers) the full amount of the bond that it paid to Four Corners Insurance Services, Inc. (Four Corners). The payment to Travelers shall include all interest and fees incurred to date; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED: That MARK W. WARDLOW shall make restitution to Four Corners in the amount of the commissions that were not covered by the Travelers bond; and it is


FURTHER ORDERED: That the individual insurance producer's license of MARK W. WARDLOW, license number 0102391, shall be suspended for a period of three (3) months; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED: That the period of suspension shall begin on July 1, 2008 or three (3) days after the execution of this Consent Order by the Commissioner, whichever is the latest; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED: That proof of the satisfaction of the amounts due and owing shall be submitted by MARK W. WARDLOW to the Commissioner, Department of Insurance, Securities and Banking, 810 First Street, NE, Suite 701, Washington, DC 20002, ATTN: Charlotte W. Parker, Assistant Attorney General, Office of Legal Affairs; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED: That if MARK W. WARDLOW fails to pay the entire amount due and owing, he shall be subject to further disciplinary action; and it is


FURTHER ORDERED: That if at any time during the period of the suspension any violation of the insurance laws or regulations of the District of Columbia or any other jurisdiction shall occur, the Department retains its right to take any administrative or regulatory action.
