This *Certification Form* is required to be completed and submitted with any application for licensure under the *Clean Hands Before Receiving a License or Permit Act of 1996*, effective May 11, 1996 (D.C. Law 11-118, D.C. Code § 47-2861 et seq.)

4. Past due taxes;
5. Past due District of Columbia Water and Sewer Authority service charges or fees;
6. Fines, penalties or interest assessed pursuant to the District of Columbia Taxicab Commission Establishment Act of 1985, effective March 25, 1986 (D.C. Law 6-97; D.C. Official Code § 50-301 et seq.);
7. Fines, penalties or interest assessed pursuant to the Compulsory/No-Fault Motor Vehicle Insurance Act of 1982, effective September 18, 1982 (D.C. Law 4-155; D.C. Official Code § 31-2401 et seq.);
8. Fines, penalties or interest assessed pursuant to the District of Columbia Traffic Adjudication Act of 1978, effective September 12, 1978 (D.C. Law 2-104; D.C. Official Code § 50-2301.01 et seq.);
9. Fines assessed to car dealers pursuant to section 2(i) of the District of Columbia Revenue Act of 1937, approved August 17, 1937 (50 Stat. 680; D.C. Official Code § 50-1501.02(i)); or
10. Parking fines or penalties assessed by another jurisdiction; provided that a reciprocity agreement is in effect between the jurisdiction and the District.

I understand that if I knowingly provide false information on this *Certification Form*, DISB will move to revoke the license for which I am applying and fine me one thousand dollars (\$1,000). I further understand that DISB may conduct an investigation to ascertain the veracity of the information contained in this *Certification Form*. If you owe fees and have an established payment schedule, please submit proof of the arrangements made to pay the outstanding debt. I understand that this *Certification Form* is now required as part of my application for a license, and that by completing it, I am not guaranteed that my license application will be approved.
