ORDER EXTENDING STAY AND INJUNCTION
UNTIL DECEMBER 9, 2017

Upon considering the Motion to Extend, the accompanying Memorandum of Points and Authorities, and the entire record, the Court finds that: 1) this Court has the power to enter orders modifying its previous Orders under D.C. Official Code § 31-1304 (2012 Repl.); and (2) the Motion to Extend should be granted.

It is therefore, this ___ day of _____, 2016, ORDERED as follows:

1. This Court's September 24, 2013 Stay Order (as clarified by this Court's Order of December 9, 2013) remains in effect and is further extended such that:

a. All litigation pending against Ocean hereby remains stayed until further order of this Court;

b. All persons and entities hereby remain enjoined until further order of this Court from commencing or continuing any litigation against Ocean;

c. All litigation pending against any Policyholder is hereby stayed for an additional one (1) year, until December 9, 2017; and

d. All persons and entities are hereby enjoined from commencing or continuing any litigation against a Policyholder for an additional one (1) year, until December 9, 2017.

2. It is further ordered that no provision of this Order, the September 24, 2013 Stay Order, the December 9, 2013 Clarifying Order, the December 9, 2015 Extension Order, or the December 9, 2016 Extension Order shall be construed, interpreted, or understood to stay, enjoin, or otherwise interfere with Ocean's right as plaintiff to take legal action to recover assets from any person, including a Policyholder.

3. This Court shall retain jurisdiction to modify or extend the stay and injunction provided herein.
