**ORDER GRANTING MOTION BY THE REHABILITATOR FOR APPROVAL OF
SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT WITH JEFFREY E. THOMPSON AND D.C.
HEALTHCARE SYSTEMS, INC.**

On November 24, 2020, D.C. Chartered Health Plan, Inc., acting through its Rehabilitator, Special Deputy to the Rehabilitator and their attorneys (“Chartered”), filed a Motion by the Rehabilitator for Approval of Settlement Agreement with Jeffrey E. Thompson and D.C. Healthcare Systems, Inc. (“Motion for Settlement Approval”). On November 30, 2020, Chartered filed a praecipe regarding the Rule 12-I Certification of the instant Motion, stating that Petitioner District of Columbia consents to the relief requested in the Rehabilitator’s Motion. The Motion for Settlement Approval requests the Court to approve the terms of a Settlement Agreement and Mutual Release executed by the Rehabilitator, Thompson and D.C. Healthcare Systems, Inc. (“DCHSI”) in the form attached to the instant Motion.

On consideration of the Motion, the Settlement Agreement and Mutual Release, and the entire record herein, it is by this Court this 4th day of December 2020, hereby:

ORDERED, that the Motion for Settlement Approval is **GRANTED**, and it is further **ORDERED**, that Settlement Agreement and Mutual Release attached to the Settlement Motion is hereby approved and the Rehabilitator and her Special Deputy are hereby expressly

authorized to take all actions contemplated by the Settlement Agreement and Mutual Release;
and it is further

ORDERED, that all claims either filed or asserted, or which could have been filed or asserted, by Jeffrey E. Thompson and/or D.C. Healthcare Systems, Inc. in this rehabilitation proceeding and against the Chartered estate, are hereby waived, relinquished, and stricken, and the Rehabilitator is authorized and empowered to complete the administration of the Chartered estate and to make distribution to providers without regard to these claims; and it is further

ORDERED, that the Rehabilitator shall report to the Court when she is prepared to propose a final distribution to providers and following the making of such distribution and when this case is ready to be closed.
