SUBJECT: CHANGE OF ADDRESS FOR SECURITIES BUREAU LOCKBOX FILINGS

DATE: APRIL 7, 2011

The purpose of this bulletin is to update the change of address to the District of Columbia Department of Insurance, Securities and Banking's ("DISB") lockbox for private courier delivered filings. The DISB requires all filings and other correspondence submitted with an accompanying check as payment of a securities professional license, registration of securities offering, or exemption or notice filing fee, must be mailed directly to the Securities Bureau lockbox at one of the two addresses listed below. **Please note that the type of mail delivery service determines which lockbox shall be used, and that all checks shall be made payable to the D.C. Treasurer.** The two lockbox addresses are as follows:

1. All filings and other correspondence containing payments that are sent via **private courier services such as DHL, UPS, FedEx and Airborne Express** must be sent to the following address:
