DEFAULT DECISION AND ORDER OF REVOCATION

The Hearing Officer enters a default decision and order of revocation against Respondent, Jean H. Lawton based upon the following facts:


1. Respondent Jean H. Lawton is licensed as a non-resident producer authorized to transact insurance business in the District of Columbia
2. Respondent's non-resident producer license No. is AI 2818577.
3. A Notice of Show Cause was sent to Respondent on January 18, 2007 informing her of the charges against her
4. Violation I of the Department's Show Cause Notice alleged that Respondent in the conduct of her affairs under the license No. AI 2818577, violated D.C. Official Code § 31-1131.12(a)(9) whereby her license was revoked by her resident State of Wisconsin. Specification I states that: "On September 18, 2006, Mr. Jim Denholm, Licensing and Contracting Manager, CUNA Mutual Group, notified the Department by letter that Ms. Jean Lawton had her Wisconsin resident producer license revoked, and that the insurer would be terminating her appointment. The Department obtained a copy of the Order of Revocation from the Wisconsin Department of Revenue, Office of the Insurance Commissioner, which confirmed the information provided to the Department by Mr. Denholm and noted that Ms. Lawton's license was revoked as a result of "failing to pay delinquent taxes"
5. The Department of Insurance, Securities and Banking sent, via certified mail signed by Adam H. Levi, Assistant Attorney General, dated January 18, 2007, Notice to Show Cause and Official Notice of Hearing, IB-SC-07-01, to Respondent at 1606



6. The Notice of Show Cause sent to Respondent, directed her to appear before the Department of Insurance, Securities and Banking, Suite 701, 810 First Street, NE in Washington, D C , on February 26, 2007 at 10:00 a m
7. After notice was duly given, a public hearing was held for the purpose of determining whether the license of Jean H. Lawton, Respondent, should be revoked.
9. The Respondent failed to appear at the Show Cause Hearing or have a representative appear on her behalf.

ORDER


